Dear Sir:

I had the pleasure of picking up the signal of your radio station on 1590 kilohertz back on the evening of January 21, 1981 at 5:29 p.m. when you were signing off. Shortly thereafter, I mailed a report of my reception to K Q X K, but have never received a reply. I was thinking that perhaps my letter was lost in the mails, so I decided to send this follow up letter. The following is a summary of my reception:

5:29 Sign Off Announcement- "K Q X K Springdale, Arkansas now comes to the close of another broadcast day. K Q X K is owned and operated by Johnson Communications, Inc., operating on a frequency of 1590 kilohertz with a power output of 1,000 watts...at 6 a.m. when we begin another broadcast day.

During my reception your signal had interference from both K G A S in Carthage, Texas and K V G B in Great Bend, Kansas. My receiver is a Hammarlund HQ-180AC and my antenna is a 2' directional altazmuth loop.

If you find this report to be correct and to your satisfaction, I would appreciate very much receiving a brief letter or card stating that my reception was indeed verified. I have 2,084 verifications, including 65 from Arkansas. Yours would be a most welcome addition to my collection. I have enclosed a stamp for your reply. Thank you for your time.
