We are in receipt of your most gratifying letter. KTNN is without a doubt, the most exciting, adventurous undertaking, the Navajo Tribe has engaged in. The pride and inspiration that KTNN has instilled in all of us is especially rewarding when we hear from you. Your acknowledgement of the first original 50,000 Watt American Indian owned radio station, KTNN is greatly appreciated.

Currently, KTNN is broadcasting 19 hours a day, seven days a week beginning from 5 a.m. until 12 midnight. We program in the Navajo language from 5 a.m. until 12 noon and the English language from 12 noon until 12 midnight. Our music format is top 40 hits, Country and Western from 5 a.m. to 6 p.m. and top 40 hits Rock from 6 p.m. to 12 midnight.

We will eventually broadcast 24 hours a day. Enclosed, please find a copy of our day-time/night-time coverage area and a KTNN Bumper Sticker.
