KZON received permission from the FCC January 23 to change  
call letters to KRDS. I hope this will still suffice for  
your KZ station in the contest; although I'm afraid it  
has been so long since we received your report the contest  
may be over.

You and several other NRC members have caught right at the  
in-between stage when we have none of the old KZON letter-  
heads left and none of the new KRDS letterheads ready yet.  
Consequently it is impossible to reply on letterhead this  
time. No coverage maps are available as yet.

We seem to be putting a pretty good signal into Omaha at  
times with our 250 w. Your's is the second or third re-  
port from Omaha. We recently received a report from  
Cleveland.
