Dear Sir:

I am pleased to verify your reception of Radio CKVN. Your programming report was correct, and your technical report was quite interesting.

Radio CKVN broadcasts from Vancouver Canada on a frequency of 1410 KHZ with a power of 50,000 watts day and night, using a pattern beam change at night. Broadcasting is normally done with an RCA BTA-50HI transmitter and a three-tower antenna array. Emergency standby facilities include an RCA 10KI transmitter and a separate two-tower antenna array. Both transmitter sites are located in the Fraser River Delta, South of Vancouver.

Radio CKVN is programmed primarily for the young adult audience. We are the oldest continuously broadcasting radio station in Vancouver and are celebrating our 50th Anniversary this year. The call letters were changed to CKVN three years ago, having previously been C-FUN.
