Thank you for your reception report which tells us how our signal is heard in your area. Our studios are located at Vaudreuil, five miles south of Cap-Haitien. Programs are sent over FM link to our transmitters at Petite Anse, east of Cap-Haitien. We generate our own electricity with diesel engines. We broadcast in two languages simultaneously.

Regular monitors help us to know better how our signal reaches different areas. Would you like to be a Monitor?

Several DX'ers send to DX Stamp Service, 466 Weaver Rd., Webster, New York, 14580, U.S.A. for stamps and enclose for return postage. This helps your letter to get out faster.

You may hear your name when you listen to "The Listener's Post". See the enclosed program schedule for the time.
