Thank you for letting us know that you heard our station. Yes, we did transmit exactly as stated on your list.

We are a Mexican station. Our call letters are XEVIP, we transmit at the AM frequency of 15-60 at 10 KW. We broadcast 18 hours a day and have a direct telephone line with CBS in New York, carrying all the CBS programs since we are an official CBS affiliate. Our audience amounts to some 400,000 people composed of bilingual Mexicans, Americans, Canadians, Australians, English and European residents.

From time to time, about once a month, we receive letters from people in the United States that let us know that they heard us. We keep these letters on file and appreciate it when we are informed that we were heard. Thanks again,
