Thank you for your reception report of December 30, 1963. We are always happy to hear from our DX listeners. We are a local station with 15,000 watts longwave. This letter is to verify your report.


YNOL operates on 828 KC using three 3X 2500 F3 tubes in the final. We have one of the most powerful transmitters in all Central America and it was constructed righthere at the station. Our antenna is a 305' vertical radiator tower. We began our minisrty on March 8, 1959.

The studio-transmitter building is located about 7 miles SW of Managua. We also maintain a recording studio downtown along with our office.

Presently we are ~~broadcasting 16 hours a day with the final hour in the English language from 9:00 - 10:00 PM daily.~~ There are many Englishspeaking people in Nicaragua.
