The frequency 570 KHz in the United States is classified by the Federal Communications Commission as a Regional Channel and stations operating on this frequency serve a fairly localized region, usually a single metropolitan area. KLAC operates with 5000 Watts of power, 24 hours daily, utilizing a two-tower directional antenna system during hours of darkness. Our radiation pattern at night concentrates the greatest portion of the signal in a generally South-Southwest direction from our transmitter site in Northeast Los Angeles. This enables us to serve. 24 hours a day, nearly all of the densely populated area of Southern California from the San Fernando Valley to San Diego.
