
This will verify your reception report of KRED Radio on October 30. KRED Radio is a 24-hour, 5,000 watt operation. From our 380 foot tower on Humboldt Bay, California, latitude 40 degrees 48 minutes 9 seconds---longitude 124 degrees 8 minutes 20 seconds. Our 5,000 watt signal on 1480 kilohertz is non-directional days and beamed north-southwest from sunset until sunrise. Our main transmitter is a Gates BCfA with Western Electric phasing equipment for our nighttime operation.

Licensed in the city of Eureka, California, approximately 25,000 population, KRED Radio serves Northern California and the great Northwest with "Gold Rush" music. Consisting of the top ten records from 1955 to the present with the generous sprinkling of Casey Kasem's American Top Forty. Our programming varies at night to Country and Western between the hours of midnight and 6am.

Eureka is the center of the famed redwood lumber industry and our deep water port on Humboldt Bay serves the world. We also have a substantial commercial and sports fishing industry, plus fine dairy herds in addition to beef, cattle and sheep.
