I had the extreme pleasure of receiving the signal of your radio station on 1540 kilohertz back on the morning of December 31, 1979 at 1:00 a.m. Central Standard Time. I mailed a report of my reception to your chief engineer shortly thereafter, but have never received a reply. Recently, fellow NRC member Rick Carr reported in our club bulletin that he received a verification letter from you. Accordingly, I decided to send this follow-up letter to you. The following is a summary of my reception.

1:00 Station Identification-"You're tuned to K Z L A Los Angeles".

1:00 Program Opening Announcement-"Ladies and Gentlemen, brothers and sisters, welcome to another edition of <a href="PREPARE">PREPARE</a>, produced by the Radio Production Workshop of Black Awareness in Television. This is called a workshop because we work in producing communications and the people who produce this program live right in the community."

Station K X E L in Waterloo, Iowa had just signed off at 1 a.m. and left your signal completely in the clear. My receiver is a Hammarlund HQ-180AC and my antenna is a 2' directional altazmuth loop. FM-1978

When did you change your call letters from K P O L?

If you find this report to be correct and to your satisfaction, I would appreciate very much receiving a brief letter or card stating that my reception of your signal is verified. I have 2,053 verifications, including a most welcome addition to my collection.
