Station KKBB 1090 (formerly KLDR, KAAT) was originally built in 1972 with a DA-day 4 tower inline array and 50 kilowatt CCA transmitter.

The system was recently moved in 1981 and updated to a system DA-2 seven tower parallelogram with 50 kilowatts day and .5 kilowatts night. Both patterns main lobes coverage extend west to north.

It is with great pleasure to verify your QSL-SWL as Dee Thompson, out station's Head Bookkeeper has checked and verified our programming log for December 24, 1982 and found your excerpt totally correct.

To say the least, this has taken me by total surprise as I myself first started in radio as a SWL in the 60's and had forgotten the thrills and excitements of finding a new station.
