Thank you very much for your report of reception of Radio Station KRXY-AM, dated January 23, 1985.

From the information you provided, we were able to verify your report as being accurate. I hope you will accept this letter as confirmation of your reception of KRXY-AM on January 23, 1985 at 9:10 PM CST.

KRXY-AM operates 24 hours a day with 5000 watts of power. During night hours we use a four-tower directional antenna system, which beams our signal to the north from the Lakewood/Denver area. It's interesting to note that Overland Park is located in one of our nulls due to protection we provide for a station in St. Louis, MO. I'm not sure what our exact power is in your direction, but it's not much more than 100 watts. That's some fair DX for the broadcast band!
