

We recieved your reception report on March 22, 1971. Your description of our reception was accurate. I was on the board during this time period. A few facts about our station may be of interest to you. We are one (1) kilowatt daytime-non directional. We are also one kilowatt directional at night. Our station is at the foot of a mountain and our night time pattern coveres mostly east and west of our direction.

Our directional array includes three steel vertical radiators series excited and each tower measures 166' above ground. The common point current is 4.05 amperes. I commend you on you thoroughness of handling reception reports. I hope that this letter will surfice as verification of your reception of our station. The staff of our station enjoys recieving these reports. Just keep up the good work...
