This is to confirm your report of reception of KDSN on Saturday the 30th of ~~September~~. We were broadcasting the playback of a local high school football game from the night before. KDSN operates on a frequency of 1580 kilocycles with a power of 500 watts. We are 2 tower directional with the strongest part of our signal going north. Omaha is definately off the rear of our pattern and quite a ways out of our usual area. KDSN has been on the air since early 1956.

Real glad to hear someone picked us up in Omaha, Carl, as I moved to Denison about a year ago after working and living in Omaha for 4 and $\frac{1}{2}$ years.
