THIS IS TO CONFIRM YOUR RECEPTION REPORT OF KYME ON DEC. 20, 1965 FROM 1:30 TO 2:00 A.M. MST. RADIO KYME BROADCASTS ON A FREQUENCY OF 740 KC'S DAYTIME WITH 500 WATTS. OUR NORMAL FORMAT IS ROCK & ROLL. TOWER HEIGHT IS 270' ---NON-DIRECTIONAL.

PLEASE EXCUSE THE "CANNED" LETTER, BUT I'M SWAMPED IN FAN MAIL.

WE HAVE BEEN RECEIVING LETTERS FROM SAN DIEGO TO ALASKA, AND FROM PORTLAND TO MICHIGAN. THIS HAS BEEN AN INTERESTING EXPERIMENT IN FINDING OUT HOW FAR 500 WATTS WOULD PUSH 740 KCS. I MIGHT ADD THAT WE HERE AT KYME WILL BE HAPPY TO COOPERATE IN THE FUTURE IN ANY WAY THAT WOULD BE HELPFUL.

THE ACTUAL TEST WAS CONDUCTED FROM 1:30 TO 2:00 A.M. (MST) MONDAY, DEC. 20, '65 BY THE STATION MANAGER MR. JAMES SCHROEDER, AND CONTAINED TONE, DX ID'S, CHRISTMAS MUSIC, STATION ID'S, ETC. OUR BEST RECEPTION SEEMS TO HAVE BEEN IN CENTRAL AND SOUTHERN CALIFORNIA AREAS, THAT IS, UNTIL KCBS (FRISCO) CAME ON THE SCENE WITH A CASUAL 50,000 WATTS. SEATTLE REPORTED PRETTY FAIR RECEPTION WITH A LITTLE COMPETITION FROM CBX IN ALBERTA, CANADA (ALSO 50,000 W.) CANADIAN AND MIDWEST DXER'S REPORT SOME INTERFERENCE OUT OF TORONTO.
