Thank you for your report of reception of WQUA on November 29, 1971. Upon checking our logs, we find that your report is accurate.

WQUA operates on 1230 kcs. with a daytime power of 1000 watts and a nighttime power of 250 watts. Our transmitter is a Collins model 820-D, with a pair of 5-500 tubes in the final power amplifier. The antenna is $\frac{1}{4}$ wavelength (208 feet) shunt-fed, self-supporting tower, providing a non-directional pattern.
