This is to verify your report of our frequency measurements on June 11, 1963. These tests are run every 2nd Tuesday of each month at 1:30am CDST during the summer months and starting with November at 12:30am until May.

Enclosed is a coverage map of our station.

I also might say that I operate amateur radio K9APD on 160 thru 6 meters. My home station consists of a CE-20-A, RME45, Lettine 240 and home brew 6 meter equipment.

The equipment here at WSDR is Entirely Gates, The transmitter is a BC500T running 500watts days and 100watts nights. The rig was running 500 at the time of the test. Control room is Gates Sa 50 console, 2 magnecord recorders, 2 Gates cartritape machines, plus remote control for the transmitter and also frequency and modulation monitors. We also have complete weather panel in control room.
