Dear Sir:

Back on the morning of December 15, 1980 I have the pleasure of picking up the signal of your radio station on 1590 kilohertz at 12:53 a.m. Central Time. I mailed a report of my reception shortly thereafter, but have never received a reply. Thinking that it possibly was lost in the mails, I decided to send this follow up letter. The following is a summary of my reception:

Announcement-"The WNTS Concert Calendar is brought to you as a public service of W N T S Radio to keep you informed about the various concerts in the Indianapolis area...Please send your concert information to: Concert Calendar, WNTS Radio, 4800 E. Raymond St., Indianapolis, Indiana 46203".

Your signal briefly dominated the frequency during my reception. The main interference was from WAKR in Akron, Ohio and both WSWW in Platteville, Wisconsin and WAWA in West Allis, Wisconsin who were testing their equipment. My receiveris a Hammarlund HQ-180AC and my antenna is a 2' directional altazmuth loop.

If you find this report to be correct and to your satisfaction, I would appreciate very much receiving a brief letter or card stating that my reception of W N T S is verified. I have 2,078 verifications, including 44 from the Hoosier State. Yours would be a most welcome addition to my collection. Enclosed is a stamp for yourreply. Thanks for your time.
