Dear Mr. Dabelstein:

Your reception report on our signals during the special test for dx listeners made on February 19, 1973, has been received. Your report agrees with the master program log for this period so this letter will serve as your verification.

WNWI is located on the campus of Valparaiso Technical Institute, on the west side of the city of Valparaiso, and is 250 watts daytime only. Our antenna is a single guyed tower of 310 feet overall with a ground system consisting of approximately 33,000 feet of copper wire buried in the conventional radial pattern. We have been on the air since December 31, 1965. Original application was made for a station on December 31, 1946, so it took nineteen years of hearings, freezes, ect., for us to finally get a station on the air.

It was a pleasure running this test for the dx'ers although I would have desired to receive many more reports than have come in to date.
