Dear Mr. Dabelstein:

Thank you for your reception report of March 28, 1972. This letter will verify the accuracy of your report.

WSBT is Indiana's oldest broadcast station having started in 1921. We operate with a full time power of 5,000 watts, different directional antenna patterns daytime and nighttime.

Our transmitter plant is located 4 1/2 miles S SE of South Bend. We use an RCA transmitter and four 275 foot towers spaced 275 feet apart, in-line, on a compass bearing of 352°. Our nighttime major lobe of radiation is in that direction.

I am sending you a map showing our daytime primary service coverage. We do not have a published map of our nighttime contour.
