It is a pleasure to confirm your reception of our station on Sunday - Sept. 16, 1962.

Perhaps you don't know, KCKN now operates with a daytime power of 1,000 watts. We do however reduce our power to 250 watts at sunset. At the time of your reception, we were operating with the 1,000 watts.

I'm sorry I wasn't in when you came by the station. Maybe we can "eyeball" the next time you make it to K. C. It would be a pleasure to take you through the "plant".

At your request, I'm enclosing a coverage map. This map indicates primary coverage of the Kilowatt, but does not show the 250 watt coverage.
