This is to confirm your reception report of 1 April, 1964. We are a 1000 watt, 2 tower daytime directional station operating on a tight middle of the road format. Most of our equipment is of Gates design using a BC-1T transmitter series feeding 2 163' towers, 80° apart at 1550 Kc.

Please excuse the long delay in confirming this, but things have been pretty busy and to top it all off, I just got married last week. I think you can see the reason for the delay.

I used to own an SX-71 a couple of years ago. I traded it for a HQ-170 which I traded for an SX-101A which I traded for some recording equipment. I still have that.
