
Dear Carl,

Thanks for the Reception report! Always glad to hear news of how our signal occasionally reaches out. I'm very interested to hear that our signal wasn't covered up by KXEL. I drive in from my city of Hillsboro to work and it's not uncommon to hear KXEL when we're still on the air!

The announcer would have been Jack Hartle reporting but the other information appears to be correct. We are a 250 watt daytime only station. Our transmitter is a Harris MW-1 (which is capable of 1000 watts if we were allowed) fed into a single omni directional antenna which is 279 ft high. (we use a choke to bring it back to the proper wavelength)
