My sincere apologies for being so late in answering your reception report. I used to enjoy broadcast DX'ing as a hobby - and still do find it fascinating to tune the AM band when I get time to do so.

I was surprised indeed to get a report from Overland Park until I read your letter further where you mentioned that KJLA went dark. Consider this letter a confirmation of your reception of KVSV AM 1190 Khz at 9 p.m. on June 23, 1990. We are a 2500 watt station with a two-tower antenna array, giving us a cardioid pattern with the null in your direction.

I would be interested in hearing anything new about the 1190 khz situation in Kansas City. I believe they had a very expensive six-tower operation with night-time signal problems. By the way, do broadcast stations still have QSL cards?
