Sign On Announcement-"At this time each day W N G O in Mayfield, Kentucky signs on the air for its broadcast day. Today is October 20, 1977. WNGO operates on an assigned frequency of 1320 kilohertz with a power of 1,000 watts. This is Ray Starr (?) inviting you to stay tuned until sign-off time this evening for programs, information and entertainment. W N G O is owned and operated by Western Kentucky Broadcasting Company, Inc. with studios and transmitter located on Division Highway, north of Mayfield, Kentucky".
