This letter will serve as a verification of your reception report of WPAD/AM/FM on October 30, 1972 from 1:00am to 1:01am CST.


In checking our program logs for October 30, I find that your description of the program material during that time was correct as listed in your report.

Here, I might mention two things that might be of interest to you and your DXing friends. First, on December 12, 1972 from 0330 to 0400 CST, WPAD/AM/FM will be conducting a DXing program in cooperation with the Newark News Radio Club. This broadcast will enable us to find out just how far away our signals travel under differing circumstances, plus give DXing fans a chance to pick up another verification. Secondly, on the FM side of things, WPAD/FM/96.9 has received permission from the FCC to increase our ERP to 50,000 watts. This could be an easy find for the FM DXers in the country. Just yesterday, for example, we had a request for a verification from Baton Rouge, Louisiana. And, that was with our current power of 36,000 watts (ERP). Unfortunately, we have no specific target date for the power increase.

If you know anyone that might be interested in trying for a QSL from WPAD/AM/FM, spread the word about our DXing program on the 12th of December.
