Dear Mr. Dabelstein,

Thank you for your letter of 17 MAR 86 regarding the apparent reception of WSJP. In your letter you cite midnight 8 DEC 83 as the time of reception. The words mentioned that make up our Station ID are correct, and by virtue of this fact alone your reception is confirmed.

Evidently your logbook or station guide is out-dated. Since November of 1982, WSJP, Murray, Kentucky has also operated a 250 night-time directional array. This array produces nulls in the general directions of the Northeast and Southwest and increases propagation toward the northwest and southeast. This effectively protects KWAH, Shreveport, LA and WNEW, New York. What you heard was actual programming and not a test transmission.

WSJP night-time directional uses a Harris MW1A transmitter in the 250 watt mode and now uses Kahn-Hazeltine AM Stereo. Our daytime transmitter is a Harris SX2.5 transmitter operated in the 1 KW mode, also with the benefit of Kahn-Hazeltine AM Stereo.

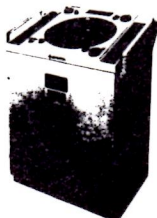
