IS A CLASS IV STATION OPERATING AT 1KW DAYTIME AND .250KW AT NIGHT...AT THE TIME OF YOUR RECEPTION WE WERE OPERATING AT 1KW SO THAT WE COULD COMPARE OUR FREQUENCY MEASUREMENT WITH CLAUDE GRAY ENGINEERING SERVICES IN BIRMINGHAM, ALABAMA... THIS TEST IS CONDUCTED MONTHLY ON THE FIRST WEDNESDAY MORNING OF THE MONTH.

SINCE RECEIVING YOUR RECEPTION REPORT I HAVE RECEIVED ANOTHER FROM A FELLOW CLUB MEMBER OF YOURS, ERNEST WESOLOWSKI. I HOPE BOTH OF YOU WILL FORGIVE THE DELAY OF MY VERIFICATION.
