Thank you for your signal report dated November 18, 1974. Please accept my apology for the delay in answering your letter, but it has been misplaced, until this time.

Yes, we did run a frequency check on that particular date, but it was exactly one hour later than what you stated in your letter. From 4:10 AM CST to 4:23 AM CST, one broadcast a 400 #2 tone 100% monitored by Southwest Frequency Measurements in Austin, Texas.

KAOK is a standard Class 4 1KW D 250 W N 1400 KHZ--we run a 3/8 wave folded unipole antenna. We have had some coverage problems with this stick so your report was very useful.
