WE ARE PLEASED TO CONFIRM YOUR RECEPTION OF RADIO STATION CKY ON A FREQUENCY OF 580 KILOHERTZ.

CKY BROADCASTS AT A POWER OF 50,000 WATTS TWENTY-FOUR HOURS A DAY WITH A GENERAL ELECTRIC BTC-50-A HIGH LEVEL TRANSMITTER, AND A FOUR TOWER ARRAY LOCATED AT STE.

AGATHE, MANITOBA, 25 MILES SOUTH OF WINNIPEG.

AT LOCAL SUNRISE AND SUNSET TIMES WE SHIFT OR BROADCAST PATTERN. DURING THE DAYTIME OUR TRANSMISSION IS BASICALLY OMNIDIRECTIONAL BUT AT NIGHT WE BEAM OUR POWER INTO CANADA'S NORTHLAND. OUR EFFECTIVE RADIATED POWER TO THE NORTH UNDER THESE CONDITIONS IS IN EXCESS OF 270,000 WATTS.

BECAUSE OF THIS GREAT POWER WE RECEIVE MANY RECEPTION REPORTS FROM COUNTRIES "OVER THE POLE" SUCH AS FINLAND, SWEDEN, ENGLAND. IN FACT, WE HAVE RECEIVED RECEPTION REPORTS FROM ALMOST EVERY COUNTRY OUTSIDE THE IRON CURTAIN, INCLUDING AUSTRALIA.
