As a fellow DXer (but not a member of any club), I'm
pleased that you were able to hear our 1kw non-directional
(at that time) signal WAY OUT WEST. I hear KFAB now and
then! on my Grundig 5000 Satellite Portable (which is also
a dandy receiver).

I have many verifications too -- although I can't
give you an exact count. One of my prizes is from BBC-TV
which I heard on a Hallicrafter receiver in 1945 or 46!!!
I heard their "sound component" as they said in their letter.

We drop power from 1kw to 500watts at local sunset
and go north (3 towers). Our FM sister-station has 16kw ERP.
Try that sometime -- but you'll have trouble from Benton Harbor,
Michigan (WHSB) which has 50kw ERP. Hi.

I also have a shortwave converter in my car (Blaupunkt)
and FM stereo! -- all German equipment. Cheers - Jim Hughes.
