I am pleased to report reception of your station on October 25, 1971
from 3:50 a.m. to 3:53 a.m. Central Daylight Time on 1560 kcs.

Items and announcements heard on this broadcast are as follows:

- 3:50 Station Identification-"...1560, this is W T P S Portage, Michigan."
- 3:51 Recorded Music.
- 3:53 Station Identification-"This concludes broadcasting for equipment testing purposes
by Radio Station W T P S Portage, Michigan."

I am sorry that this is not a more detailed logging, but I just happened to be tuning
across the channel at 3:50 and heard the above identification. This is a follow up
report to W T P S. My original report was never answered, however, Bill Nittler of
Englewood, Colorado, a fellow DXer told me that he received a letter from WTPS and that
I should perhaps write another letter as, perhaps my original report was lost in the
mails. If you find this report correct and to your satisfaction, I would appreciate
receiving a brief letter or card stating that this report is correct. I have over
1,100 verifications, including 27 from Michigan. Yours would be a most welcome addition
