Dear Carl,

Thank you for the reception report received from you this week.

Please accept this letter as verification of your reception of Radio Station WXOX, on December 10, 1973, 5:00 a.m. CST (6:00 a.m. EST).

WXOX Is a daytimer runming 1 kw, into a one-eighth wavelength antenna, 115 feet tall. (Kind of a short stick, huh?)

The transmitter is a Gates BC-1-J, 1 kw / 500 w job using 807's driving a pair of 833A's. The modulator usis the same line-up. (833A's)

By the way, at the time you logged us, we were running 500 watts, as prescribed by our pre-sunrise authority.

Most of the equipment used at WXOX is Gates. We have just wax installed a new control room, and have nearly 100% Gates gear. In my estimation, the best broadcast products available.
