Dear Sir:

I received your report of your reception of KTIS sign-on the other day. This letter is in verification of this report.

KTIS is, as you know, owned by Northwestern College of Minneapolis, Minnesota, and is the key station for our network of four stations. Your will note that we also own and operate KNWS in Waterloo, Iowa. It is also a one (1) kilowatt station operating at 1090 Kc. on a daytime schedule.

KTIS operates on 900 Kc, one kilowatt power on a local sunrise to sunset basis. KTIS-FM operates on 98.5 Mc., 3 Kw. transmitter power, with 5.3 Kw. E.R.P., unlimited time. Our equipment is basically Western Electric with some of our studio equipment by Gates.

I am sorry we do not have a coverage map of any of our stations.
