We received your letter yesterday and today I checked our Station program log against your summary and found it to be accurate.

I am personally familiar with your organization all though I am not a member.

For your information, KAAN-AM went on the air just about a week aga, December 4, 1983 and this is the first such "DX" inquiry we have received. For the past five years we have been broadcasting on KAAN FM, 95.9. Our FM power is 3000 watts, so I doubt whether you could receive it. Our AM power is 250 watts on 870. The 870 frequency and good soil conductivity in this area has given us good signal in Missouri, Iowa, Kansas and Nebraska.
