
This is to varify your letter concerning your reception of KGMO's frequency test on 1550 kcs.

KGMO moved from 1220 kcs. to 1550 kcs. on Nov. 1st and boosted it's power to 500 watts. At that time several tests were begun in order to maintain KGMO's carrier frequency within FCC specifications. Then, December 20th, KGMO threw the switch to 5,000 watts of power to make KGMO Southeast Missouri's finest radio station.

KGMO has a 2-tower directional array. Our signal is attenuated slightly to the east. KGMO is a daylight to dark station operating with a Gates BC5P2 transmitter.
