Dear Mr. Dabelstein

We have received your reception report of KJPW-AM and are pleased to verify it. Please accept my apologies for not answering your last report. Since I just began working at KJPW recently, I am not sure what happened to it.

KJPW uses a Gates BC-IT transmitter at 1000 watts with a 300 foot antenna. Although our address is Waynesville, the actual location of the studios and tower is in St. Robert. St. Robert is about a mile to the east of Waynesville and just north of Fort Leonard Wood.

KJPW has a sister station on FM, KYSD. The stations simulcast until KJPW signs off at sunset. KYSD signs off at 10 pm. The FM transmitter is a one kilowatt Gates FM-1H.

Again we are pleased to receive your reception report. I am enclosing one of our window stickers and copies of our coverage contour maps. As a DX'er myself, I wish we had a QSL card for you. I don't have near as many QSL's as you but just for trivia's sake my best catch was either Radio Caroline North off the coast of England or KDKD. Both were made while I was stationed in Asmara, Ethiopia.
