from 1:40 a.m. to 1:45 a.m. Central Standard Time on 1240 kcs.

Items and announcements heard on this broadcast are as follows:

1:40 A test tone.

1:43 Station Identification-"W M I S Natchez, Mississippi, W M I S Natchez, Mississ-
ippi 1240 kilocycles, W M I S Natchez, Mississippi."

1:43 The tone continued.

1:45 The tone ended. Perhaps, this was the end of your transmission.

This is a follow up report to W M I S. I mailed a report to your station shortly
after the above reception, however, no reply was ever received. Perhaps, it was
somehow lost in the mails.
