Dear Carl,

Thanks for your reception report for February 1 1962 from 11:25 to 11:30 Pm CST. Which is 10:25 to 10:30 PM MST. This was one of our new programs which is one the hour and the half-hour. This is a verification of your reception.

As for information about the station, our transmitter is a 5kw, water-cooled Western Electric, Mosel 355-D-1. The antenna system consists of two vertical steel radiators. The Northwest tower is 211 feet high, tapered, self-supporting and series excited. The Southeast corner tower is of uniform cross-section, guyed, shunt excited, and supports a TV antenna. It's overall height is 440 feet. We are one of the few station in the country with complete radio and TV facilities in the same building. Our chief Engineer is Anthony J. Lopuch.
