from 7:00 p.m. to 7:06 p.m. Central Daylight Time on 930 kcs.

This reception was made from the University of Nebraska Field Laboratory near Mead, Nebraska (30 mi. north of Lincoln) using a specially constructed Beverage Antenna. This antenna is 3200' long, 5' high, on a bearing of 300°. It is an end-fed, ground-terminated, unidirectional antenna.
