Dear Carl:

This letter is to confirm your DX report of October 24, 1979. We're beginning to grow accustomed to receiving DX reports around here. We installed a Collins 828E-1 transmitter in May when we increased our power to 5000 watts and every report I receive is further testimony to the performance of the finest piece of broadcast equipment I know of on the market. At the time you picked us up, we were operating at 2500 watts. This is critical hours power. We are 2500 watts from local sunrise, then two hours later we go to 5000 watts. We return to 2500 watts two hours before sign off until local sunset when we go off.

Thank you for your interest in WKGX and may I express my appreciation for your DX report. Here's another one to add to your verification list.
