Dear Carl:

I have received your reception report of January 28 and am happy to report that it bears out with our programming log for that date.

Since you are interested in the radio business you might be interested in a few facts about our station. We are 250 watts power, non-directional. We have a 159 ft self-supporting tower which is fed by a Collins 300J transmitter. June 12th will be our 12th anniversary on the air.

We now have an application before the FCC requesting permission to switch to 1590kc with 5,000 watts daytime power and 1,000 at night. This would be using a five-tower directional array, beamed mostly to the north, using 190 foot guyed towers. In addition we are thinking of putting in FM facilities at that time as well.

We also have two-way radio gear, G.E.....100 watts base station & two 60-watt mobile units which permit us coverage through most of our area. These operate at 26.15 mc.
