## Dear Sir:

I am writing you in connection with my reception of K C I A. Some time ago, I sent to your chief engineer a report of my reception of your station on 1110 kilohertz, which I heard on November 2, 1976 at 5:45 p.m. Central Standard Time. I have awaited a reply, but as of yet, I have never received an answer to my letter. Several of my fellow National Radio Club members have received correspondence from reception reports to K C I A over the years, so perhaps mine was somehow lost in the mails.

The following is a summary of my reception during the above period:

5:45 Sign Off Announcement-"...another day's broadcasts on K C I A.
Tomorrow morning we invite you to...K C I A is located in Humble
City, New Mexico. K C I A is owned and operated by...Listen to
K P O E FM Stereo 94 for beautiful music..."

The reception of K C I A was at a fair S-4 signal level with considerable interference from K D R Y in Alamo Heights, Texas who was also signing off, and K F A B in Omaha, Nebraska. My receiver is a Hammarlund HQ-180Ac with 18 tubes, and my antenna is a 2' Directional Altazmuth Loop.

Please check over the details of this report, and if you find it to be correct and to your satisfaction, I would appreciate receiving a brief letter or card stating that my reception of K C I A is verified. I have 1,889 verifications, including 45 from the State of New Mexico. Yours would be a most welcome to my collection. I have enclosed return postage for your convenience in making a reply to this request.
