I was very pleased to receive your letter of contact and reception of our station, as were all the AM KATTS. You are right we do run 1KW Daytime only with a PSA (Pre-Sunrise Authority) of, if you can believe this, 8.4 Watts. Our licensed frequency is 1140 KHz as you indicated.


Being from Wichita, Kansas myself I am familiar with where Overland Park is and it pleases me to know that we were heard up there with that kind of a Signal to Noise figure.

I hope you will be proud to add this to your other 2,023 verifications.

Just as a note of interest if you ever have ther time and the necessary equipment, we also run a 24 Hour FM KATT on 100MHz with a transmitter output power into the antenna of 35KW and an ERP of 100KW H&V.
