This letter confirms your reception of KWEY on December 24, 1973 from 12:08 am to 12:12 am, central standard time.

KWEY is a two-tower directional, daytime operation from 6:00 am to Sundown (FCC schedule time), with power of 1,000 watts at 1590 kcs.

The broadcast was for frequency measurement.


Our directional operation has two nulls, with three required check points. One null is north at 2 degrees, other null is 76 degrees East-North-East. Our small lobe is North-east at 39 degrees, and our very large lobe is Southwest at 219 degrees.

KWEY has been on the air since June 1, 1970, one of the last AM stations to be licensed since the FCC freeze. All New equipment, Gates, in new building under one-roof. Good operations, excellent acceptance in area, on profit side of ledger.

Yes, we're proud of our Sooners, just as I know you are mighty proud of the Corn Huskers. They're both BIG Reds.
