THANK YOU FOR YOUR LETTER DATED FEBRUARY 12, 1973. FROM THE INFORMATION CONTAINED IN YOUR LETTER I AM PLEASED TO CONFIRM YOUR RECEPTION OF WEEO.

WEEO IS A FAIRLY NEW STATION, BEGINNING OPERATION ON JANUARY 12, 1971. WEEO IS A 1KW, THREE TOWER, DIRECTIONAL STATION. MOST OF THE STATION EQUIPMENT IS "GATES". FROM THE ENCLOSED COVERAGE MAP YOU CAN SEE THAT THE MAIN LOBES OF THE SIGNAL GO IN A NORTH-SOUTH DIRECTION. THE EXTREMELY HIGH SUPRESSION TO THE EAST IS TO PROTECT WNEW IN NEW YORK.

THIS TEST WAS NOT A SPECIAL TEST FOR N.R.C. BUT A ROUTINE MEASUREMENTS TEST WHICH IS RUN TWICE EACH YEAR IN FEBRUARY AND SEPTEMBER.

THANK AGAIN FOR YOUR REPORT AND I HOPE YOU CAN LOG WEEO AGAIN IN THE FUTURE.
