We are in receipt of your letter giving us your report of reception during the time from 4:01 AM to 4:02 AM Central Standard Time of our WVBR Radio Station, for which we thank you.

We are a new station which began official broadcasting on May 18, 1964. We operate from 6 AM to 8:30 PM during the summer months, but actually this is a daylight operation and programs must be scheduled from sun-up to sun-down. We can reach a listening audience of approximately 175,000 persons.

At the present time, we are entirely out of our coverage maps and programs schedules, these being sent out to different agencies and persons running for public office. However, if you are still interested in these within the next month or so, do contact us.
