Thank you for your letter of March 15th, reporting reception of CHAB on that date at 6:00 to 6:15 am CST.

I have checked our log and am pleased to report your items as correct.

CHAB began as an amateur broadcasting station in 1922 as 1OAB. In 1933 this was changed to CHAB. In 1959 CHAB Radio was joined by CHAB Television operating on Channel 4.

CHAB now operates on 800 kilocycles with a power of 10,000 watts. The transmitter is located seven miles west of Moose Jaw in the heart of southern Saskatchewan.
