Dear Carl:

Was very much pleased to get your report of June 20, 19 63 and upon checking of your report with the engineering dept. I find it to be of great accuracy.

WDXN conducts it's regular frequency checks on the third Thursday morning of each month, 1:10 to 1:25 AM CST.

You mention the fact that you heard WDXI on 1310kc earlier. Pleasingly I inform you that WDXI is the Central office of all the stations of the Dixie Network. WDXI is a 5000 watt station daytime and 1000 watts (dir.) at night.

Our station WDXN is 1000 watts (ND) daytime only. The transmitter is the Gates model BC-1 feeding a 368 FT. vertical radiator. The transmitter is remotely controlled and located about 3 miles north of Clarksville.

The studios are in the Bailey Building on Second St. in Clarksville.
