
Dear Carl:

This will confirm your reception of WJTZ, Blountville, Tennessee, on April 15, 1991, from 04:30 AM to 04:50 AM EDT.

WJTZ operates on 640 KHz, 5 Kw non-directional day and 810 watts directional nights and is located in the center of the Tri-Cities of Kingsport, Bristol and Johnson City in Northeast Tennessee. WJTZ is in the process of applying, as soon as the FCC lifts the freeze on AM applications, for 10,000 watts daytime non-directional.

During the test, 4:30 to 5:00 AM, WJTZ operated nondirectional with 5,000 watts. Morse code was interspersed with music during this time. Please excuse the poor morse code. The Hewlett Packard 206A Audio Oscillator was keyed by a telephone type lever switch on audio console, not the best way to send code...
